## WEEK 1 — NOTICING WHEN THINKING CHANGES

**Skill Focus:** The learner practises *awareness* only (not fixing yet).

Student message (shown once):

This week you are noticing what happens in your head while you read. You are not fixing. You are just noticing.

There are no wrong answers. The goal is to tell the truth about what happened in your head.

### DAY 1 — Theme: Dog & Bag

#### Outcome (Day 1)

**By the end of Day 1, the learner can notice and report when their thinking changes as information becomes longer or more detailed.**

#### Progression (Day 1)

- **Block 1: One sentence becomes harder by adding details (fast / time / place / alone)**
- **Block 2: Short paragraph becomes harder by adding a sentence and more information**
- **Block 3: Learner identifies *what slipped first* (detail vs order)**
- **Block 4: Learner practises noticing changes in different reading styles (instructions, speech, 2 facts)**

## DAY 2 — Theme: Cat & Shoes

### Outcome (Day 2)

By the end of Day 2, the learner can **notice exactly when a new detail causes difficulty**, and recognise when they needed to look back.

### Progression (Day 2)

- **Block 1:** Detail stacking (soft / upstairs / alone / all day) increases memory load
- **Block 2:** Sentence addition increases attention and tracking demands
- **Block 3:** Learner identifies *first point of struggle*
- **Block 4:** Learner generalises the skill to short tasks (star / two words / speaker / picture / 2 facts)

## DAY 3 — Theme: Food & School

### Outcome (Day 3)

By the end of Day 3, the learner can notice changes in thinking when time and place are added, and recognise when order becomes harder to track.

### Progression (Day 3)

- **Block 1: Adds colour + time + alone + home (detail overload)**
- **Block 2: Multi-step classroom sequence becomes harder with additions**
- **Block 3: Learner distinguishes between *detail slipping* vs *order slipping***
- **Block 4: Transfer to mixed task types (write / words / speaker / picture / facts)**

### DAY 4 — Theme: Toys & Playground

#### Outcome (Day 4)

By the end of Day 4, the learner can **notice how added detail and action speed affect focus**, and track when their thinking becomes unstable.

#### Progression (Day 4)

- **Block 1:** Adds colour + place + time + alone (more to hold)
- **Block 2:** More actions/events make tracking harder
- **Block 3:** Learner reflects on what became hardest (details, actions, order)
- **Block 4:** Learner applies awareness to instruction + picture + speech + facts

## WEEK 2 — KNOWING WHEN TO STOP BEFORE IT'S TOO MUCH

Student message (shown once):

This week you will practise stopping early when your thinking starts to feel wobbly.

Stopping early protects your thinking. It is not quitting.

### DAY 1 — Theme: Dog & Bag

#### Outcome (Day 1)

By the end of Day 1, the learner can **stop at the first sign of difficulty** instead of waiting until they forget.

#### Progression (Day 1)

- **Block 1:** Stop when the sentence first feels tricky
- **Block 2:** Stop when paragraph length increases
- **Block 3:** Learner evaluates whether they stopped *early/on time/too late*
- **Block 4:** Stop during quick small tasks (not after guessing)
